



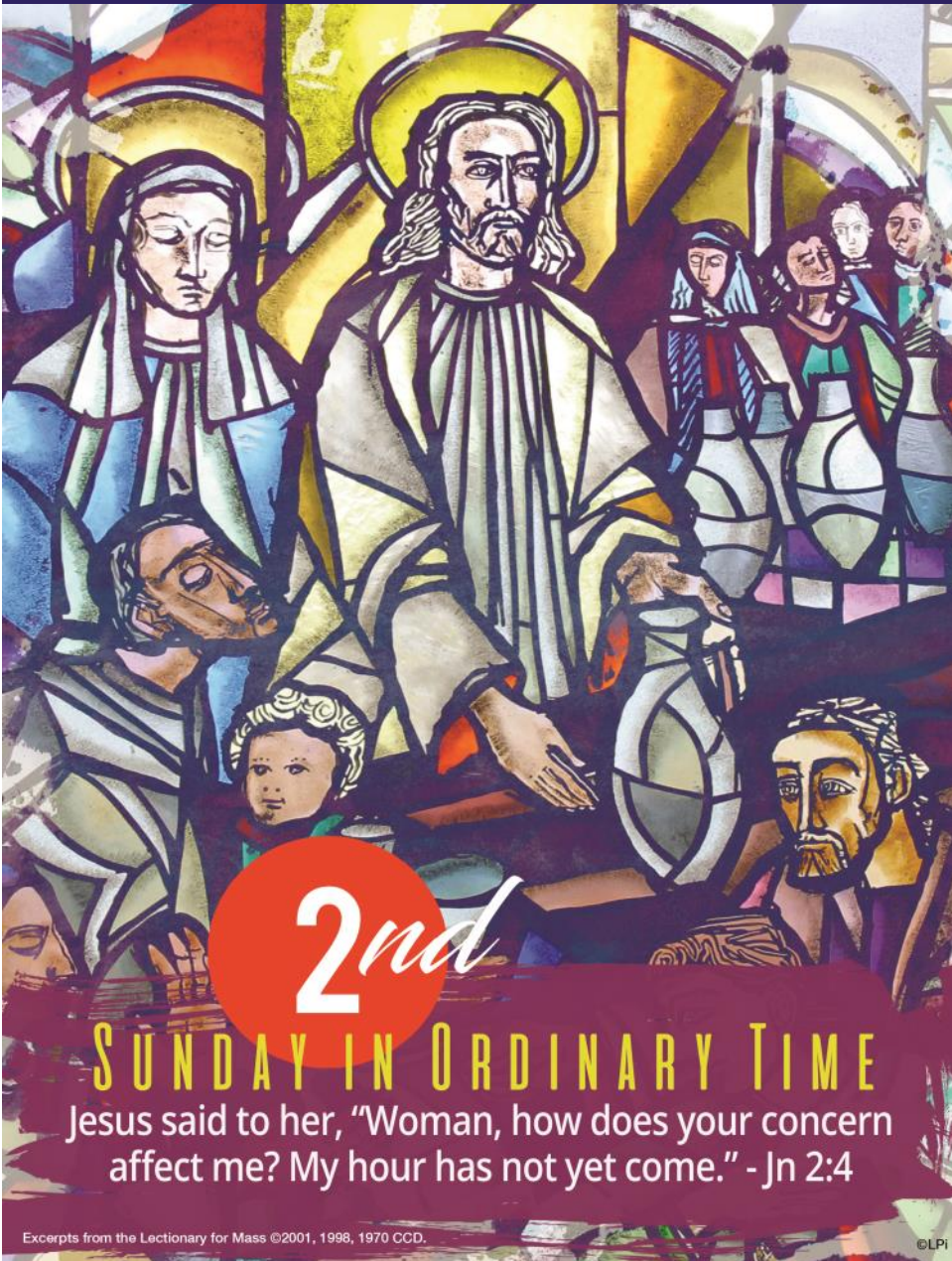

K of C Monthly Meeting 2/10

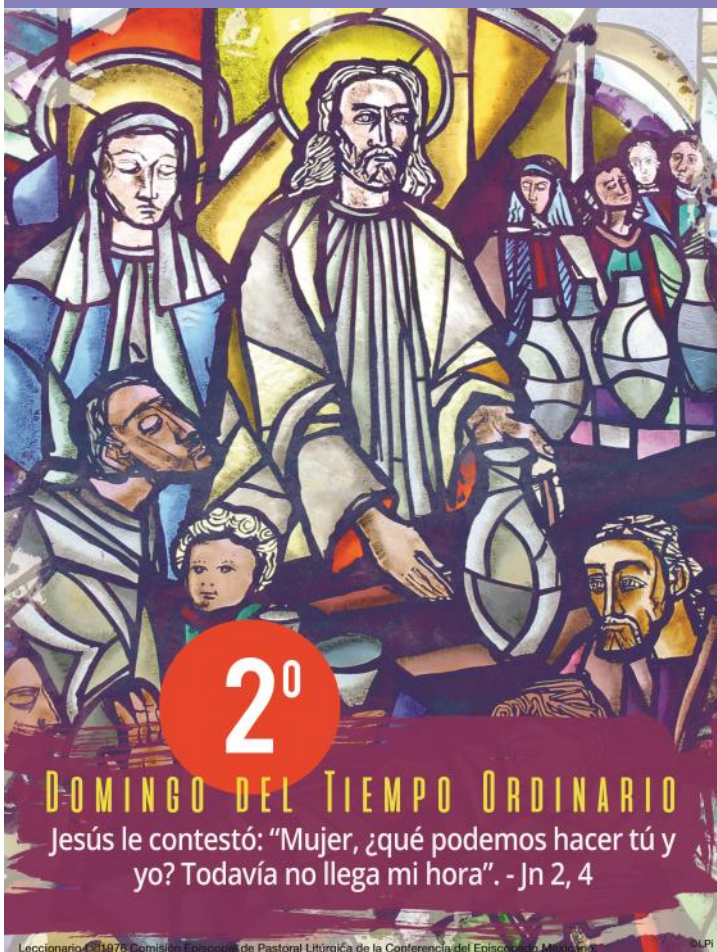
