



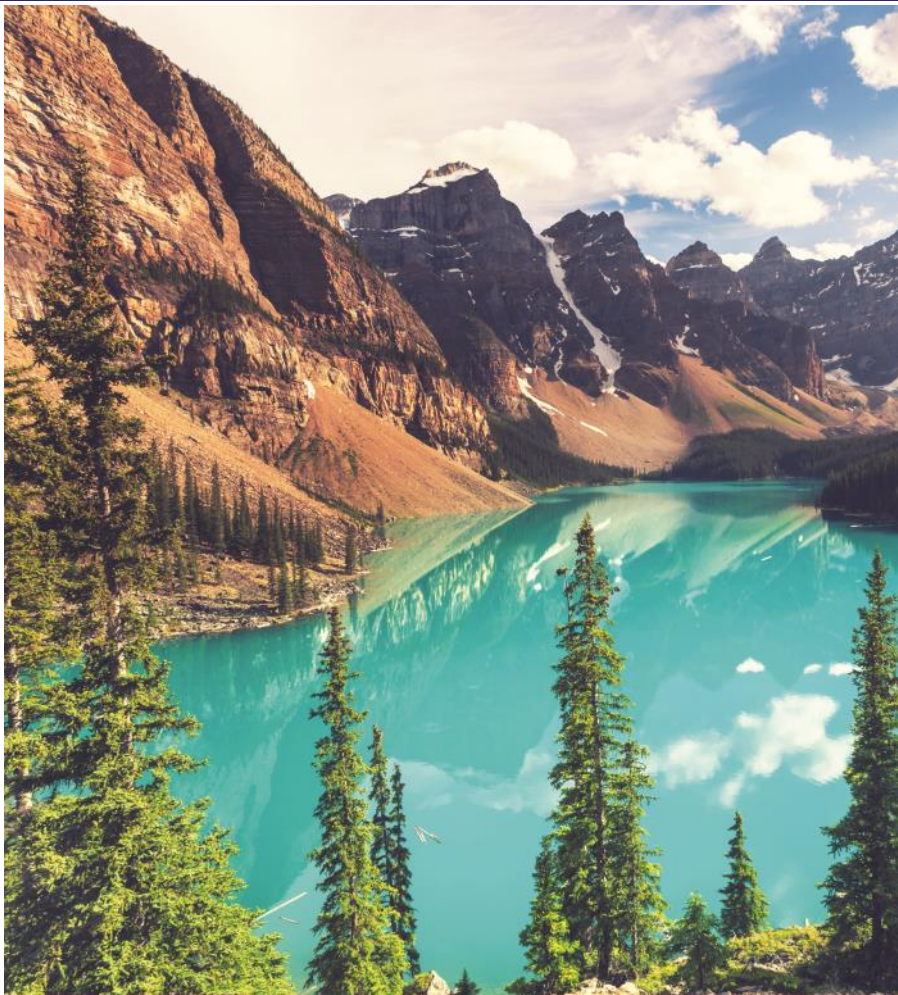

Adult Faith Formation Summer Session

What does it really mean to be a disciple of Jesus? In the Bible, Jesus says to His followers, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free: (John 8:31-32) How do we discover this "truth" and how do we spread His Word throughout the world. In *Discipleship*, Fr. Anthony Gittins, Ph.D will help us to understand the two vital elements that compose discipleship: mission and evangelization. Fr. Gittins, C.S.Sp., M.A., Ph.D., is a widely experienced missionary pastor and Professor of Theology and Culture at The Catholic Theological Union since 1984.
