



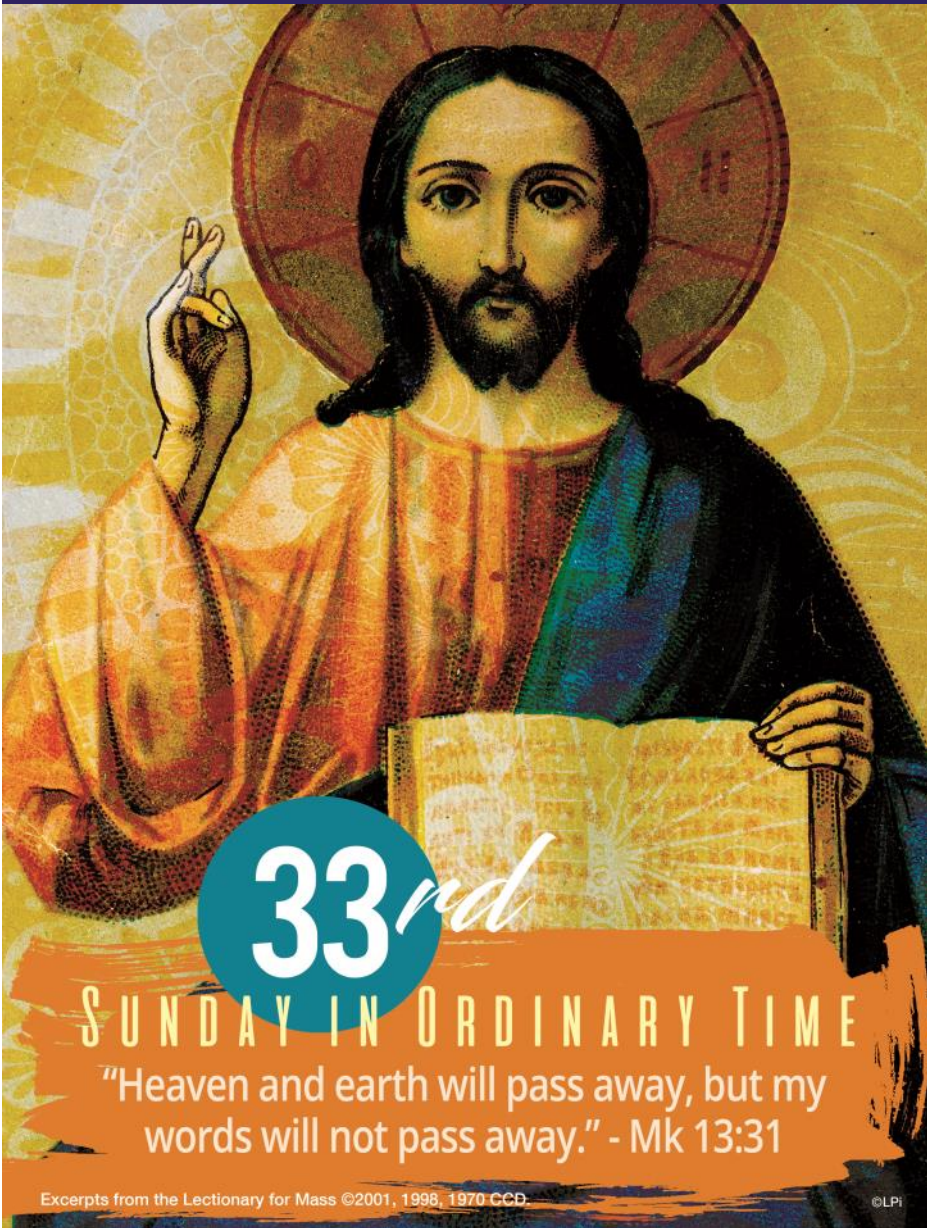

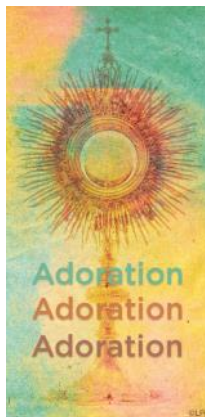

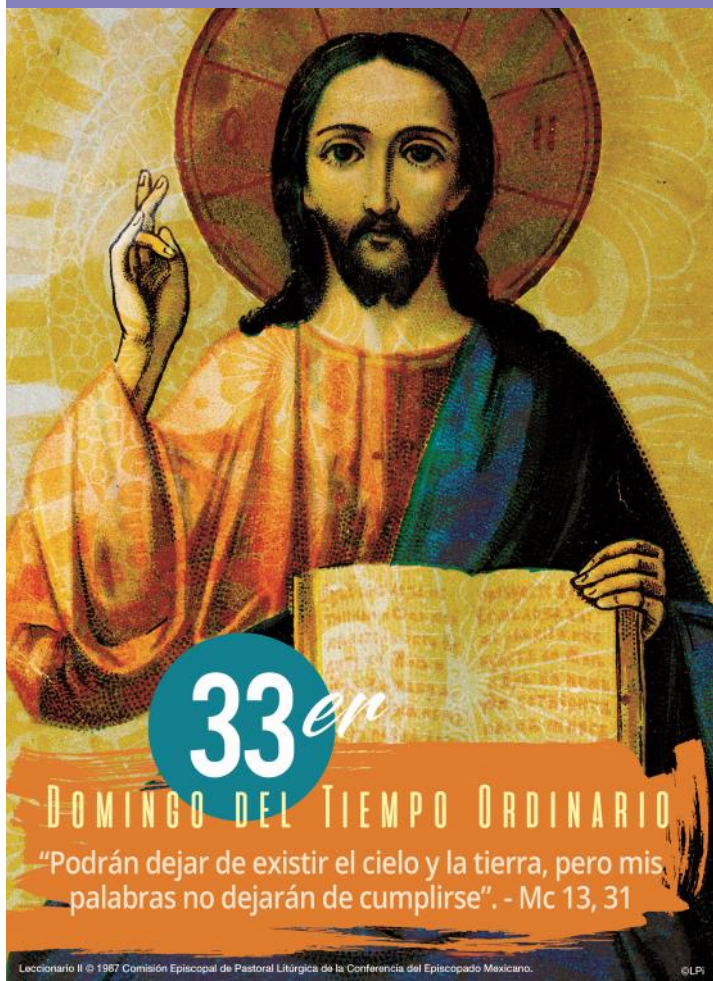
### Interested in Becoming Catholic?
