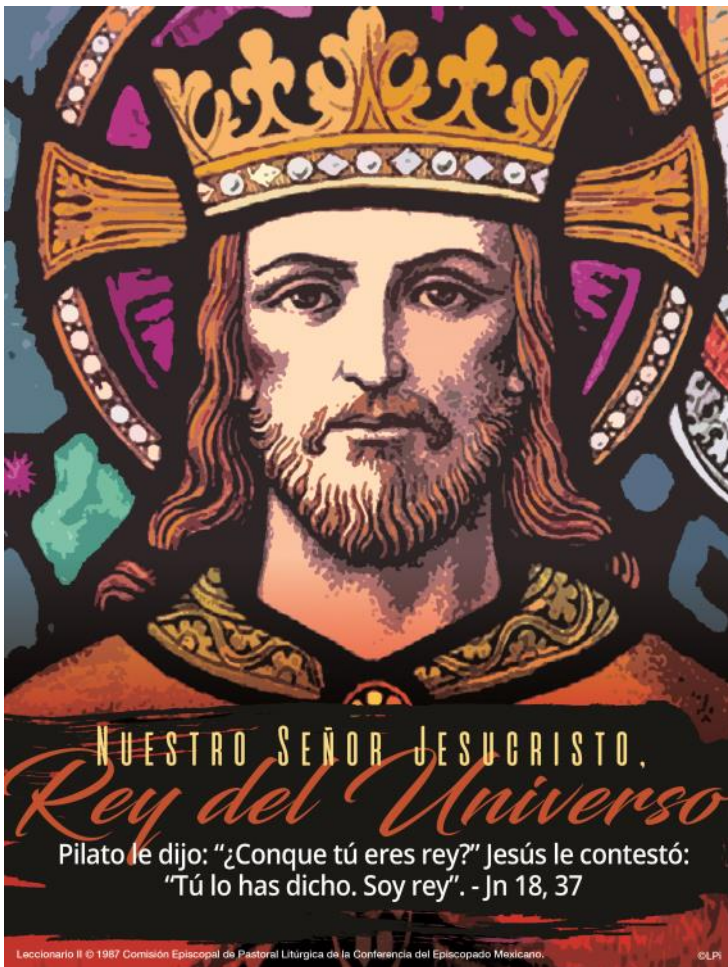


### College Student Mass and Dinner
