



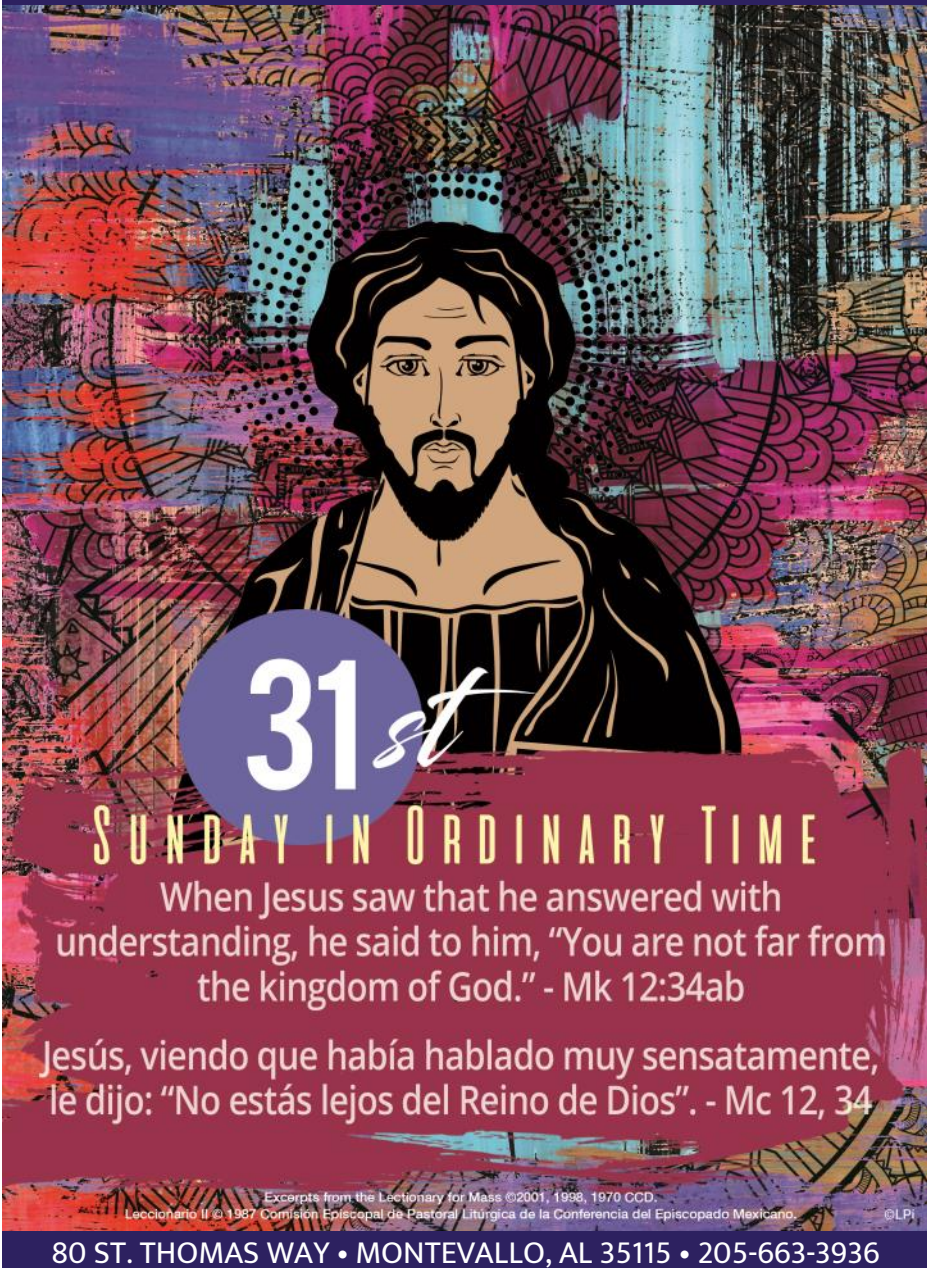

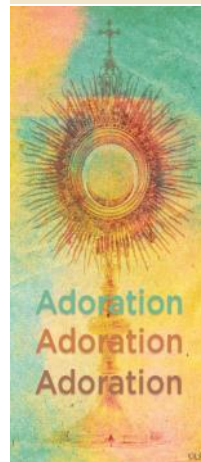

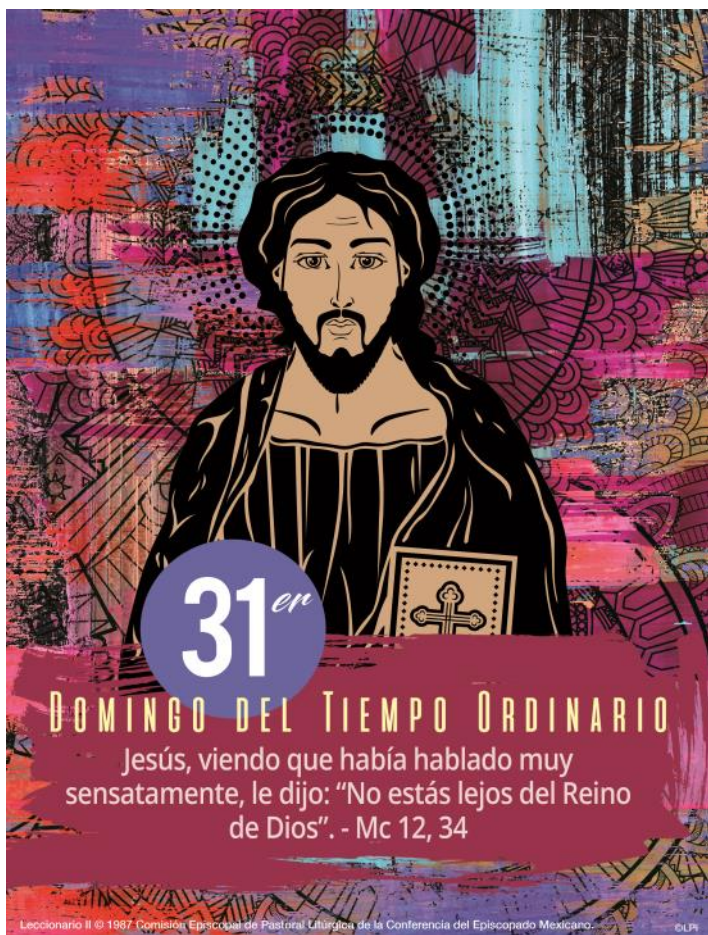
## Angel Tree
