



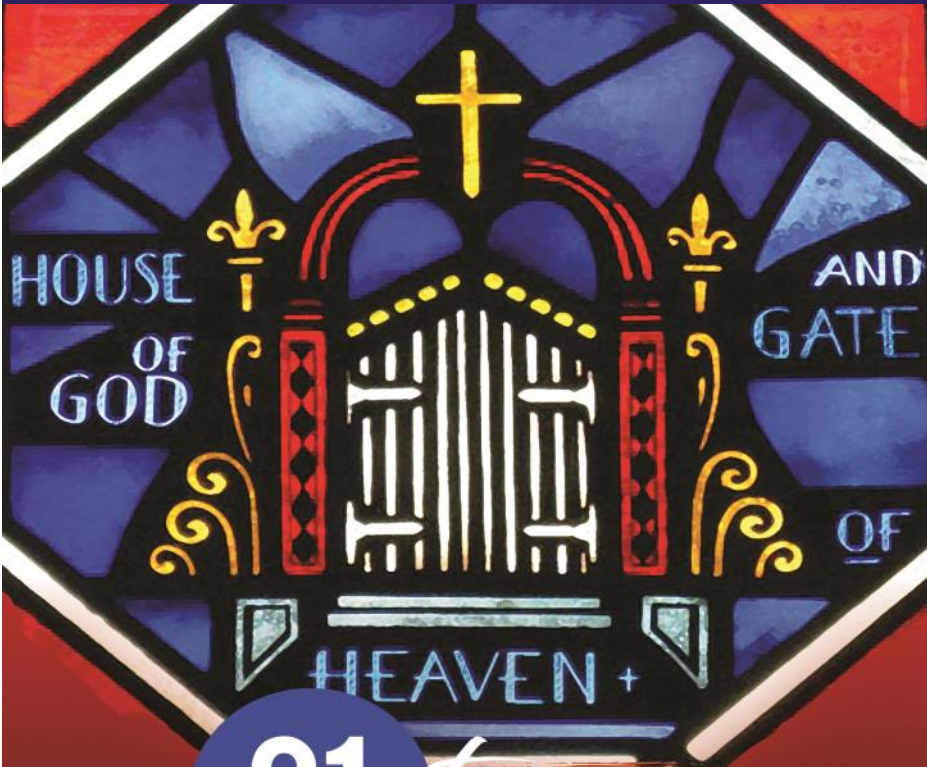

### Interested In Becoming Catholic 9/8

You may have been coming to Catholic Church for a long time with a family member or with a friend, or today may be the first time that you have ever attended a Catholic Church. Are you interested in becoming Catholic? Would you consider that possibility now? Would you like to learn more about the Catholic Church to consider your decision?

The process to learn about the Catholic Faith is called the RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Sessions are held on Sunday mornings from 9:30 AM to 10:45 AM in the Modular Building. The sessions are led by a team from the parish. The sessions meet during the school year from September to May.

This process is for you if you have never been Baptized, and you would like to be Baptized in the Catholic Church; if you have been Baptized in another Christian tradition, and you would like to join the Catholic Church; or if you have been Baptized in the Catholic Church, but you have not yet received either First Communion or Confirmation.

The first session for the new school year will be on Sunday, September 8<sup>th</sup>.
