Confirmation Retreat Team

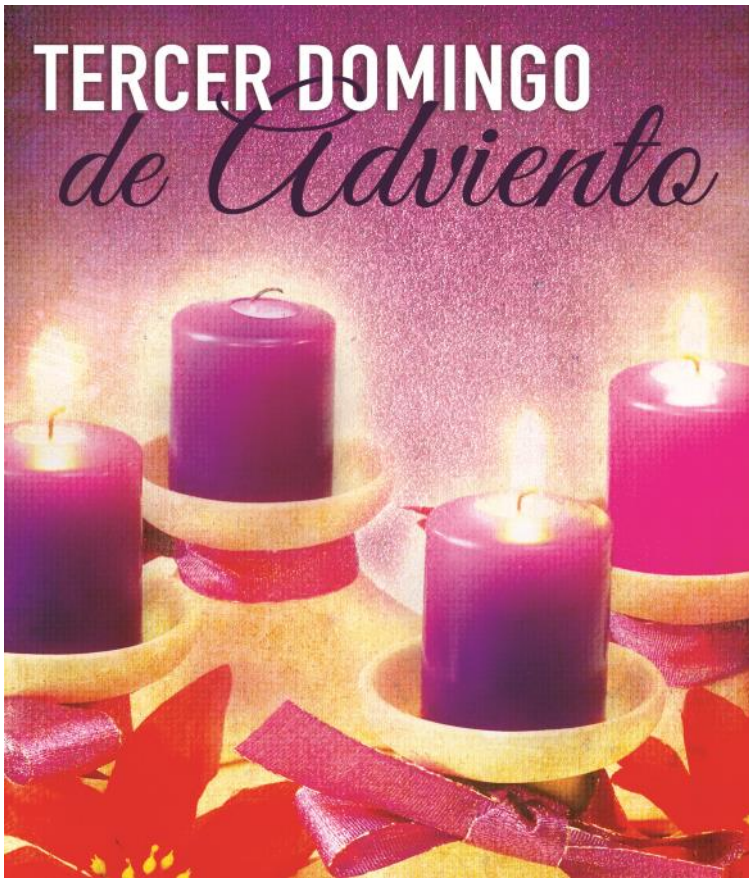
