



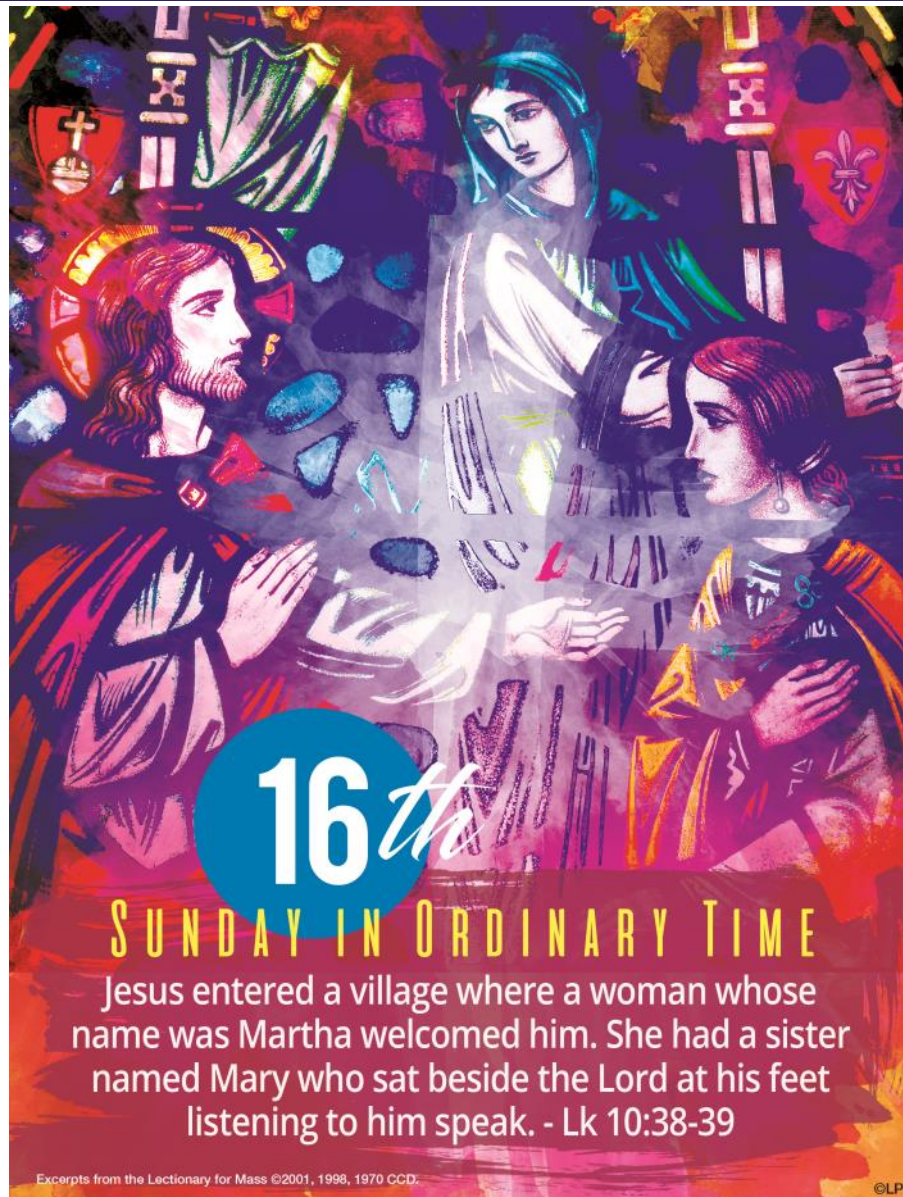

I have contacted our IT person, and he told me that it is a phishing exercise. Unfortunately, there is nothing that we can do to stop it. I apologize for any inconvenience.

I promise you that if I am in need of assistance, I will contact you in person or by telephone. I will not contact you by email or by text. Thank you for your understanding.

Faith Formation Registration 8/11 & 8/18

Adult Faith Formation Summer Session

What does it really mean to be a disciple of Jesus? In the Bible, Jesus says to His followers, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free: (John 8:31-32) How do we discover this "truth" and how do we spread His Word throughout the world. In *Discipleship*, Fr. Anthony Gittins, Ph.D will help us to understand the two vital elements that compose discipleship: mission and evangelization. Fr. Gittins, C.S.Sp., M.A., Ph.D., is a widely experienced missionary pastor and Professor of Theology and Culture at The Catholic Theological Union since 1984. A member of the Congregation of the Holy Ghost, Fr. Gittins has taught, offered workshops, and given retreats in more than 35 countries from Africa to the Pacific.. Each session will consist of a 20-25 min. video presentation by Fr. Gittins followed by group discussion/sharing.

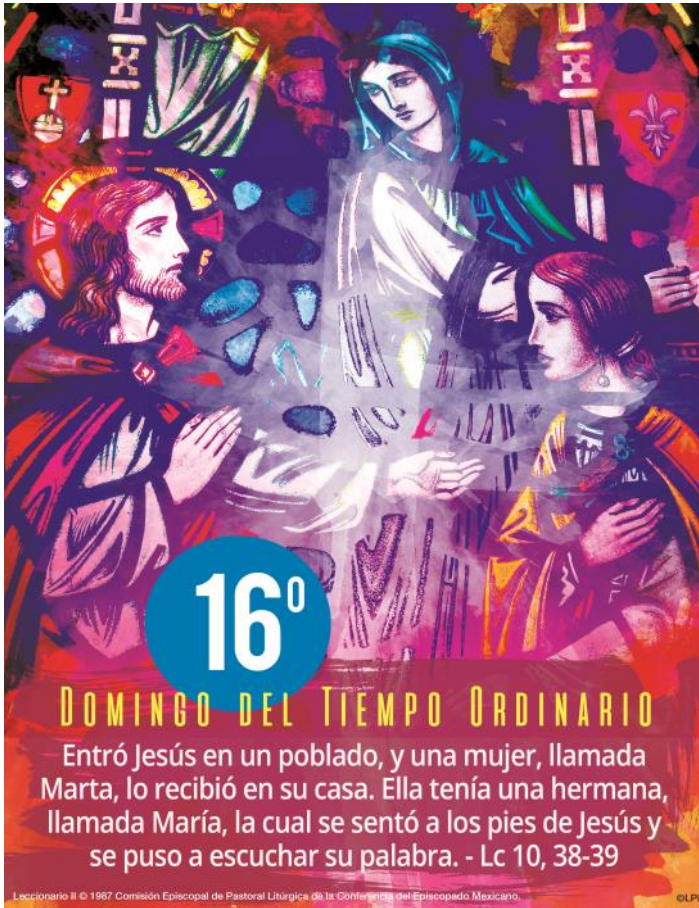
Catholic Charismatic Renewal of Birmingham 19th Annual Conference on July 26 and 27
