



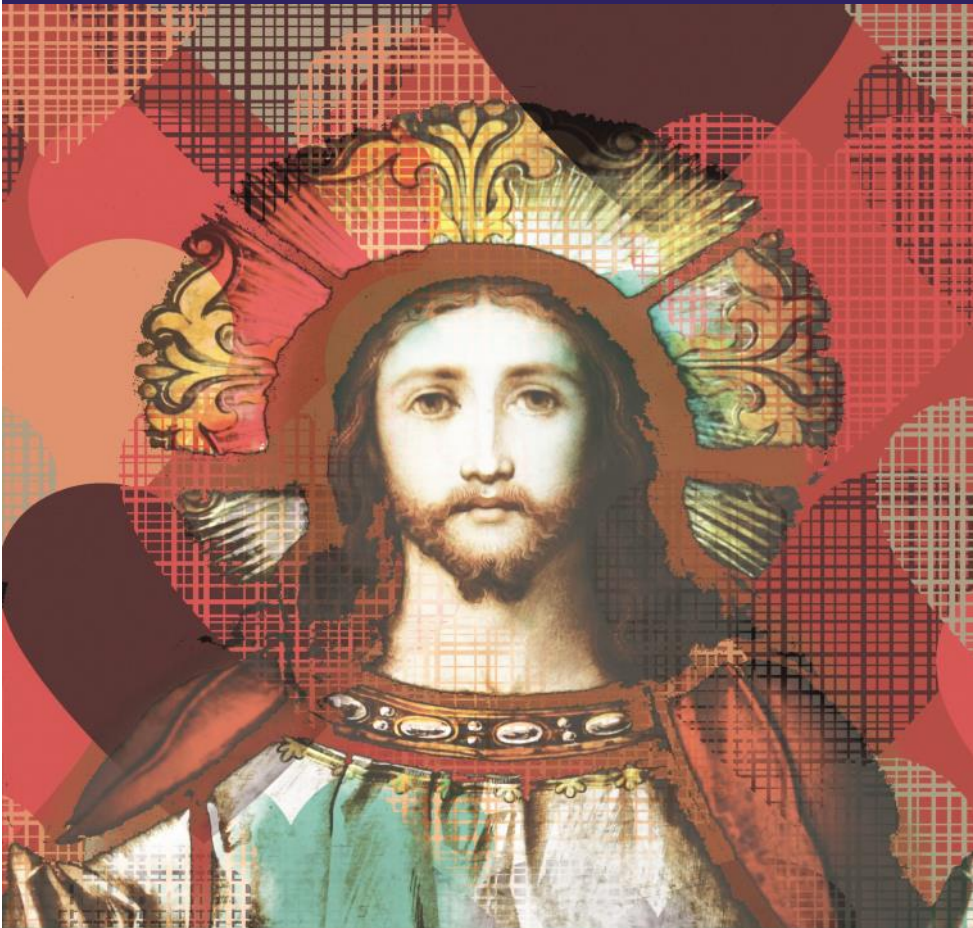

### K of C Meat Sale 5/30

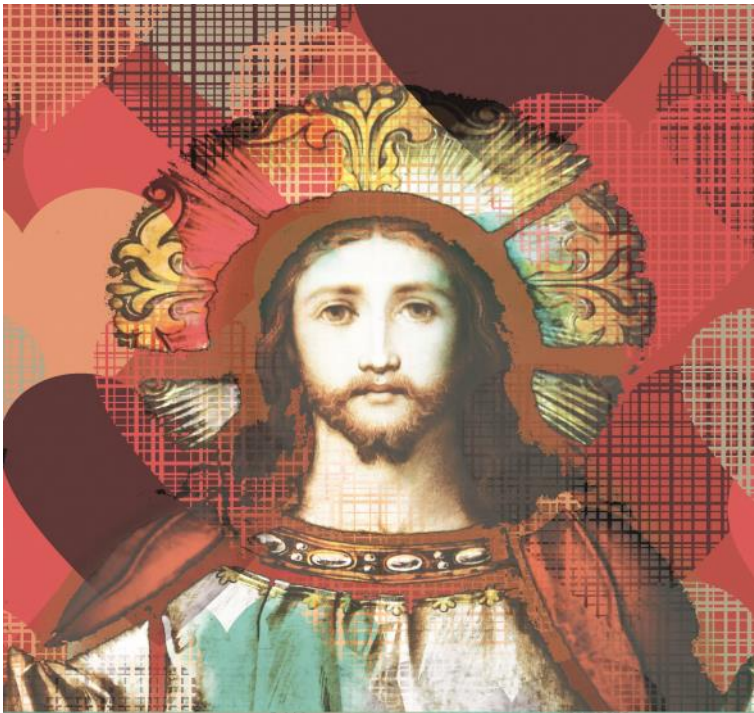
